DRIVER EDUCATION INFORMATION SHEET

Registration for Driver Education is on a first-come, first-served basis. You must submit the following information to the Mount Mercy Academy Main Office during the registration period to register for Driver Education: Please register by Monday, September 13, 2010. There is a limit of 16 students.

3. Copy of NYS Learners Permit

You MUST attend EVERY scheduled class. According to New York State regulations, you can not miss any of the 48 hours of driver education instruction.

You must attend every scheduled class for driver education. Students will be required to make up any missed road sessions prior to completion of the course. Make-up sessions are at the discretion of AAA. AAA will allow one makeup per student to be scheduled at AAA discretion free of charge; any subsequent make-ups would be offered at a rate of \$50.00 per student per make-up with the limit of two make-ups total. You must be 16 years of age and hold a valid New York State learner's permit to register for Driver Education. You must maintain a good driving record during the semester. Your Blue Card will be withheld or denied if you are involved in traffic violations/accidents during Driver Education.

The classroom sessions start on Monday, September 20, 2010 and will be held every Monday and Wednesday after school from 3:00pm until 4:30pm, and drive times are available after the classroom sessions on Mondays or Wednesdays with additional drive times on Saturdays. Classroom and drive sessions go through Saturday, November 20. Therefore you will need to attend both classrooms each week as well as 2 driving sessions each week which include 1 drive time after class and 1 on Saturday. See below for in car session details.

The drive times also start Monday, September 20. You will need to attend 2 classroom sessions per week as well as 2 drive times. Because of the acceleration of this program you need to attend **each session** as scheduled. You will be contacted prior to the session beginning with your schedules.

All students will be scheduled to drive after class on either Monday or Wednesday. In addition ALL students must drive on Saturday as well. Times on Saturdays are either 8:30am-10am (limited to 16 spots) or 10am-11:30am (limited to 16 spots).
