Tips and Guidelines for Videos:

- PLAN YOUR VIDEO FIRST!! You can use a story board: see other side.
- Videos should be no longer than 8 minutes.
- Make sure to hand in the \$5 dollar fee and this application by **March 12, 2010** to Mrs. Penepent
- A second form for you to fill out and permission slips for those in your film will be given to you when this application is handed in.
- Film must be submitted by the **March 27th** deadline to be considered for an award.
- If you are taping a video to be dubbed, make sure you have the sound turned off or have silence around you while filming.
- You will need to get permission from anyone in the video to use their image. You will receive this form when you submit this application and the \$5.00 fee. If the person is under 18, you must have their parent's permission. Everyone in your video must sign a permission slip for you to use footage of them. Therefore make sure they will be able to have permission in advance.
- Make sure your camera is stabilized so viewers don't get seasick from shakiness.
- If you are filming one person or a small group while they interact make sure to be up close.
- Frame your subjects- this does not always mean centered! Play with this before you shoot, then when you have an image you like, go for it!
- Make sure lighting is good.
- Have light behind the camera person, NOT behind the people or scene being taped.
- Make use of background music.
 - If you use a song or music that is copyrighted (i.e. : anything popular, current, or recorded since your parents were born!!) you may only use 30 seconds of the music.
